Dominion Securities – D. Wares (arr. 10:00 a.m. – dep. 10:34 a.m.)

D. Wares gave a presentation to the F&EDC outlining the M.D.'s investment portfolio. He told the Committee that he has been working with the M.D. since 2010 and manages the reserve funds as per the Municipal Government Act (MGA). He noted that interest rates have been very challenging in the last decade and said the interest rate is just starting to increase this year. He told the Committee that he tries to ensure 2 – 3% interest on the funds, but over the past five years, the interest has been approximately 1.2%. He stated that M.D. funds are not too narrowly or too broadly invested. He also said that liquidity will be important with upcoming large projects the M.D. has.

D. Cooper said it looks like the M.D. is in a stable position. D. Wares agreed.

D. Cooper asked the delegation if they had a good relationship with M.D. Administration. D. Wares said it was very good and noted that he only contacts Administration approximately three times per year. He finished by telling the F&EDC that the portfolio is very responsible.


